<b>Product Name</b> >>	VHB Surface Cleaner - Part Ref: SC108
<b>Critical Hazards</b> >>	Highly Flammable. May cause eye irritation
<b>First Aid Measures</b> >>	<b>Inhalation:</b> Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, get immediate medical attention.  <b>Eye Contact:</b> Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of water. Get immediate medical attention.  <b>Skin Contact:</b> Flush skin with large amounts of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.  <b>Ingestion:</b> If swallowed, call a medical doctor immediately. Only induce vomiting at the instruction of a medical doctor. <b>Handling and Storage:</b> >>	<b>Precautions for safe storage:</b> Keep container closed when not in use.  <b>Fire Prevention:</b> Ground containers securely when transferring contents. Wear low static or properly grounded shoes.  <b>Explosion Prevention:</b> Flammable liquid & vapour. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flame, and other sources of ignition.
